Reclamation of the Bagnoli Coroglio (NA) coastline

In the last century, Bagnoli became, unfortunately, a byword for industry, pollution and destruction of a beautiful coastline. Today, Bagnoli stands for reclamation, reconversion, development and, above all, the major challenge of restoring to the Neapolitans “their” beach at the foot of the hill of Posillipo. A challenge transformed into the plan drawn up by the Province



and Municipality of Naples, in cooperation with the Ministry of the Environment, which envisages recovery of the small pier and beach, moderate urbanisation, for tourist facilities, of former industrial sites, the creation of large landscaped areas, parks and a “social space” for meetings and cultural events.

Fenice was awarded the tender for the reclamation works of the 3 main lidos of Coroglio; 26,000 sq. m of beach, 45,000 m³ of sand contaminated by hydrocarbons, metals and other pollutants stemming from decades of industrial activity, that will be extracted up to a maximum depth of 4 metres, treated with **soil washing** in order to remove the contaminants present and then repositioned in situ enriched with new sediment.
